

DECORATOR TIPS

1 PLAN YOUR SPACE

6 BRING IN NATURAL ELEMENTS

7 THINK ABOUT LIGHTING

Use a mix of ambient, task and accent lighting to create the right mood in every room.



8 USE MIRRORS WISELY

Mirrors reflect light and make spaces feel bigger and brighter. Place them across from windows.



9 KEEP IT BALANCED

Balance colours, textures and furniture. Mix big items with smaller ones to create harmony.



10 DON'T FORGET THE RUG

A rug anchors the room and ties everything together. Make sure it's the right size.



11 STYLE THE SMALL DETAILS

Accessories like vases, books, candles and trays add the finishing touch. Less is more.



12 MAKE IT PERSONAL

Add items that tell your story—photos, souvenirs and keepsakes make your house feel like home.
